

### A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SUNDANCE BEACH TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF MUNICIPAL ASSESSOR

**WHEREAS,** section 210 of the MGA (as defined below), describes the appointment of designated officers;

**AND WHEREAS,** pursuant to section 284.2 of the MGA, a council of a municipality must appoint a designated officer to carry out the powers, duties, and functions as municipal assessor;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Council (as defined below), duly assembled, enacts as follows:

### 1. SHORT TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "Municipal Assessor Bylaw".

#### 2. **DEFINITIONS**

- 2.1 Definitions used in this Bylaw, if not defined in this Bylaw, shall have the same meanings attributed to those definitions in the MGA.
- 2.2 In this Bylaw:
  - a) *"Council"* means the Council of the Summer Village;
  - b) **"MGA"** means the *Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 Chapter M-26* together with any amendments thereto and replacements thereof; and
  - c) *"Summer Village"* means the Summer Village of Sundance Beach.

#### 3. POSITION OF ASSESSOR

- 3.1 The position of Municipal Assessor (as defined in Section 284.2 of the MGA) is hereby established as a designated officer of the Summer Village in order to carry out the duties and responsibilities of a Municipal Assessor as set out in the MGA.
- 3.2 The Council shall appoint, by resolution as necessary from time to time, an individual to act as the Municipal Assessor established pursuant to Section 3.1 of this Bylaw.



# 4. GENERAL

4.1 Each provision of this Bylaw is independent of, and severable from, all other provisions and if any provision is declared invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this Bylaw remain valid and enforceable.

### 5. REPEAL

5.1 This Bylaw shall replace Bylaw No. A16 (Establish the Position of Designated Officer) and Bylaw No. A16 is hereby repealed.

## 6. COMING INTO FORCE

6.1 This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon final passing.

**READ** a first time this 19<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2020.

**READ** a second time this 19<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2020.

**UNANIMOUS CONSENT** to proceed to third reading this 19<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2020.

**READ** a third and final time this 19<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2020.
